



1 For his Ultimate concept, Jason MacIsaac built three smokestack-shaped spaces in a variety of woods. He furnished them with the fractal Oru bench by Troop, Jaime Hayón's playful ceramic creations for Lladró, and Paul Loebach's Himmeli pendant lights. ministryoftheinterior.net

2 Faced in aluminum and encapsulated in a maple box, Science + Sons' prototype for Radio Canada (designed by Tristan Zimmermann) features two pre-selected stations: CBC Radio One and Two, naturally. scienceandsons.com

3 The Brothers Dressler nabbed the Radostar Design Award at Studio North by rescuing school chairs and reinforcing their tubular steel legs with locally sourced walnut braces. Leather offcuts and wool and felt scraps make up the seat cushions. brothersdressler.com

4 Hansgrohe launched the upscale Axor line's Starck ShowerCollection, a series of 12-by-12-centimetre chrome and brushed nickel modules that come together into a custom spa. The user-friendly system can be installed horizontally, vertically or asymmetrically. hansgrohe.com

5 Belgian radiator manufacturer Jaga's exuberantly colourful Play rad keeps the hot parts hidden from little tykes' wandering fingers. The copper and aluminum low-H₂O heat exchanger is housed in an MDF case and features soft, rounded corners. It can be connected to the wall or floor and includes an integrated, lockable thermostat. jaga.be

6 Grohe's Rainshower Icon in moon white and eco-green features a hand-set button for controlling water consumption. Winner of a 2009 Red Dot Design Award, Icon also makes removing lime scale easy; just swipe a finger over the head. grohe.ca

7 Atelier LC2 of Quebec launched Kyoto, a gorgeous dining table in walnut, oak or birch, equipped with a leaf that folds up and tucks under the tabletop. atelierlc2.com

8 Room B of Calgary strips the dining chair to its basic elements: this sleek geometric form is offered in solid oak, maple or walnut hardwood, with finishes that include bleached oak and ebony. To reduce production time and waste, the company uses the same legs for all of its seating options, then swaps the seats and backs for varied vibes. roomb.ca

9 Jaime Hayón shows his playfully poetic side with porcelain. Case in point: his Lover's Garden, one of three handcrafted creations for Lladró's Scenes collection, where the protagonist plucks a heart from the garden and it promptly changes to a radiant red. Only 100 pieces of each figure are available. lladro.com

10 Edmonton's LightForm debuted new work by Diesel for Foscarini. Fork's fabric shade with denim-inspired stitching has 360-degree adjustability. lightform.ca

11 The almost two-metre high Chelsea shelving system, by Roberto Lazzeroni for Lema, is made in three different thicknesses and finished in dark oak, oak tobacco or matte lacquer. Use it as a bookshelf or a room divider. lemamobili.com

12 Primavera Interior Furnishings rolled out glossy vinyl wallpapers by French design studio Élitis. Dolce Vita depicts a bonsai forest. The pattern comes in four colourways, including deep blue/black (shown) and mother-of-pearl/forest green. primavera.ca

13 Developed by Vancouver's Michael Gottschalk, the enviro-friendly Blu Stone tub is made of 80 per cent recycled quartzite material and 20 per cent polymer resin. The surface is stain and scratch resistant, and the shape and colour can be customized. blubathworks.com
